Ass Prof Dr Ajay Kumar is an international commercial lawyer specialising in international taxation, development and financial crimes.

He started as a qualified lawyer in India, and after more than ten years of practice, principally as a litigation lawyer, he moved into academia.

Presently he holds a full-time academic position with the University of Bradford, where he teaches international taxation, Trusts and Banking & Finance and is of Counsel to PB First Global Tax.

The University of Manchester awarded Dr Kumar a PhD in International Economic Law in (2015) for the thesis – 'International Tax Coherence a Development Perspective'. The thesis focuses on tax jurisdiction and examines the principles and practices of the international tax regime while evaluating its efficacy for offering development. This is being developed into a monograph for publication by 2024.

He has also co-authored a book published by Kluwer on 'The Public International Law of International Taxation: Text, Cases and Materials', with Asif Qureshi.
